Re: SB 937 (Wiener) – Request for VETO

Dear Governor Brown:

On behalf of the chambers of commerce that comprise the United Chamber Advocacy Network (UCAN) and their nearly 4800 combined members, we are opposed to Senate Bill 937 (Wiener) and respectfully urge your veto.

Similar legislation, Assembly Bill 1976 (Limon) seeks to achieve the same objective of accommodating nursing mothers in the workplace, yet provides for a hardship exemption and clarifying language regarding what temporary spaces are appropriate as lactation accommodations.

Therefore, we urge you to sign AB 1976 and veto SB 937 which is redundant and overly burdensome to small employers.
